



SELF CERTIFICATION SMOKE & CARBON MONOXIDE ALARM DECLARATION

*"Small Town Atmosphere
Outstanding Quality of Life"*

Smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are required to be installed in a single family or multifamily dwelling unit(s) anytime a permit is obtained. As per sections R314 and R315 of the 2022 California Residential Code, smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are required to be installed in the following locations:

Smoke Alarms (per section R314.3):

1. In each sleeping room.
2. Outside each **separate** sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
3. On each additional story of the dwelling, including basements and habitable attics and not including crawl spaces and uninhabitable attics. In dwellings or dwelling units with split levels and without an intervening door between the adjacent levels, a smoke alarm installed on the upper level shall suffice for the adjacent lower level provided that the lower level is less than one full story below the upper level.
4. Smoke alarms shall be installed not less than 3 feet (914 mm) horizontally from the door or opening of a bathroom that contains a bathtub or shower unless this would prevent placement of a smoke alarm required by Section R314.3.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms (per section R315.3):

1. Outside of each **separate** sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
2. On every occupiable level of a dwelling unit, including basements.
3. Where a fuel-burning appliance is located within a bedroom or its attached bathroom, a carbon monoxide alarm shall be installed within the bedroom.

Combination Alarms (per section R315.4):

1. Combination carbon monoxide and smoke alarms shall be permitted to be used in lieu of carbon monoxide alarms.
